Raiders 12, Packers 20

- The Raiders drop their first of the preseason by a score of 20-12, bringing their preseason record to 1-1.
- The Packers victory is their second-consecutive win against the Raiders in preseason action, the last one coming by a score of 31-21.
- The Raiders loss evens the preseason-series at five wins apiece, dating back to their first tilt in 1970.

First-Half Defense Proves to be Stout

- After giving up an opening-drive touchdown to the Packers, the Raiders' defense settled in and put together five consecutive stops against the Packers' offensive unit. A three-and-out would ensue on the following drive, followed by a fourth-down stop, and the Raiders' defense then recorded three-straight three-and-outs to end the half. The Raiders held the Packers to seven first-half points and 142 total yards of offense.

NFL/Preseason Debuts

- **RB Taiwan Jones** opened his 2016 preseason debut with a 33-yard kickoff return, the Raiders second-longest return of the preseason thus far. Jones added two catches for five yards and two carries for three yards.
- **CB Antonio Hamilton** made his NFL debut receiving a punt which he called for a fair catch in the second quarter.

Special Teams Touchdown

- With 3:04 remaining in the game, **S Brynden Trawick** blocked a P Tim Masthay punt and watched as **S Nate Allen** recovered it in end zone, recording the Raiders' only touchdown of the night.

August 18, 2016

WR Seth Roberts

- **WR Seth Roberts** led both teams with 50 yards receiving on four catches, including a game-long 33-yard pass from **QB Connor Cook** early in the fourth quarter.
- Roberts' night brings his preseason total to a team-high 59 yards on five receptions (11.8 yard avg.)

WR Johnny Holton

- After shining on special teams in his NFL debut last week against the Cardinals, **WR Johnny Holton** recorded his first NFL reception, bringing in a 3-yard pass from **QB Matt McGloin** in the third quarter.
- With 13 seconds left in the third quarter, fellow rookie **QB Connor Cook** found Holton deep for a 21-yard reception, his longest of the preseason.

WR Amari Cooper

- In the first quarter, **QB Derek Carr** connected with **WR Amari Cooper** for a 20-yard gain, the longest reception of any Raider during the first half of play.
- Two plays later, Cooper caught his second pass from Carr, finishing his night with two receptions for 21 yards (10.5 avg.).

DE Khalil Mack

- Leading the way for the Raiders defense was **DE Khalil Mack** who recorded his first sack of the preseason, dropping QB Joe Callahan for an 8-yard loss on the first play of the drive with 2:37 remaining in the first half. Mack finished the night with four total tackles (one solo).

CB Sean Smith

- **CB Sean Smith** finished as the game-leading tackler while only playing in the first half. He recorded six total (five solo) tackles, including one for loss (-1 yards) late in the first quarter.

LB Shilique Calhoun

- Rookie **LB Shilique Calhoun** recorded his first sack in the NFL, getting to QB Marquise Williams for a nine-yard loss. Calhoun's sack held the Packers drive to just a field goal in the fourth quarter.

K Sebastian Janikowski

- After the offense orchestrated a 9-play, 43-yard opening drive, **K Sebastian Janikowski** capped it off by putting the Raiders on the board when he split the uprights from 46 yards in the first quarter. Janikowski is now 2-for-2 in the preseason after his 53-yarder last week in Arizona.

P Marquette King

- For the second consecutive week, **P Marquette King** punted five-or-more times, this week registering six punts for 288 yards (48.0 yard avg.), three of which pinned the Packers' offensive unit inside the 20-yard line. King's final punt of the night, a 66-yarder in the final minutes of the fourth quarter, is now his longest of the 2016 preseason.

K Giorgio Tavecchio

- In the fourth quarter, **K Giorgio Tavecchio** made his first field goal attempt of the preseason from 28 yards out. Tavecchio's field goal cut the Packers lead to 17-6.
